Programming that is separate from the club (ie: academies, private training, small group sessions, etc.) will be required to seek CMSA endorsement annually and the endorsement of all other districts that they operate in. In addition, CMSA reserves the right to withdraw its endorsement at any time due to non-compliance of this policy.

CMSA defines these soccer training provider programs as: groups not operating as a club or entity who do not form teams to enter any ASA or CMSA sanctioned activity, and other sanctioned competition, or any unsanctioned activity. These entities are registered independent organizations that only provide supplemental training for players.
